

Raffle Rules – Grande Prairie Youth Emergency Shelter Society

Diamond Pendant Raffle

1. Tickets will not be sold to persons under the age of 18. A notification of this will be included on the purchasing site.
2. All draws will take place at the Pomeroy Hotel – 11633-100 Street, Grande Prairie AB T8V 3Y4 on April 29, 2017. Ticket sales will cease at 12:00pm on April 29, 2017
3. All members of the Sunrise House Board of Directors and committee are eligible to purchase tickets. The Raffle Chairperson will not be eligible to purchase tickets.
4. If fewer than 50% of tickets have been sold by April 21, 2017 then a draw date extension may be made upon AGLC approval.
5. Prize must be accepted as awarded and will be guaranteed for one year from the draw date. Cash equivalency will not be allowed.
6. Prizes shall be awarded as follows:
 - a. The first prize is a Diamond Pendant with a total appraised value of \$54,472.25. The first ticket drawn will be awarded this prize. This ticket will not be placed back into the drum for second prize draw.
 - b. The second prize is Trip for 2 to Puerto Vallarta, Mexico with a total appraised value of \$4,000. The second ticket drawn will be awarded this prize. Travel prize must be used within one year. Extension will be granted upon request and blackout dates may apply.
7. No refunds will be given to any ticket buyer requesting a refund
8. The number of tickets for sale will be 450 at \$100. Tickets may be purchased by Visa or MasterCard through an online purchasing system managed by Evergreen Park, accessed through www.sunrisehouse.ca.
9. Tickets will be sold and advertised within the Province of Alberta. This does not exclude people coming into the province to purchase tickets.
10. Prizes won by a deceased person will be awarded to their estate.
11. To claim a prize, the winner must present photo identification and sign a prize release form.
12. A person who does not own a ticket or share of a ticket in the draw along with one executive member of GPYESS will make and witness all draws. All draws will be open to the public.
13. In the event a winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, the licensed charity shall award the prize to one of the individuals identified on the ticket, and that licensed charity and the AGLC are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
